 Draw 2d and 3d shapes-dotty; paper can help Recognise and build simple 3d shapes, including making nets. Illustrate and name parts of a circle including radius, diameter and circumference Know the diameter is half the radius Watch http://www.iseemaths.com/lessons56/ Shape Puzzles part 1 TTrockstars Practice long multiplication and division 	 Ask your child to read a chapter of their book. Following this, ask them to summarise the events of the chapter Present the events as a comic strip Investigate any unknown words they have read using dictionary Look for any clues in the word eg. Hydro, aqua, photo Write a profile of favourite/least favourite character Make a set of 'Top Trumps' based around the characters
Weekly Spelling Tasks (aim to do one per day)	Weekly Writing Tasks (aim to do one per day)
 Investigate hyphenated words Encourage your child to practise the Year 5/6 Common Exception Words (see list) Then ask your child to choose 5 Common Exception words. They can then write a synonym, antonym, the meaning and an example of how to use the word in a sentence. Practise spellings on https://spellingframe.co.uk/ Your child can create a vocabulary bank about their St George and the dragon. They may want to use this for some of their writing tasks this week. Get your child to proof-read their writing from the day. They can use a dictionary to check the spelling of any words that they found challenging. This will also enable them to check that the meaning of the word is suitable for the sentence. 	 Write a newspaper article on St George defeating the dragon Write the fight from the dragon's point of view Turn George into the baddie and the dragon into the hero. What would this story look like? Make a comic strip telling the story Create a non-fiction poster about St George and the Dragon. Write and illustrate a fact file about dragons. Research and write about the Patron Saints of the United Kingdom. Some of these tasks will take more than one session.
