 investigate 'ough' words Encourage your child to practise the Year 5/6 Common Exception Words (see list) Then ask your child to choose 5 Common Exception words. They can then write a synonym, antonym, the meaning and an example of how to use the word in a sentence. Practise spellings on https://spellingframe.co.uk/ Your child can create a vocabulary bank about VE Day. Get your child to proof-read their writing from the day. They can use a dictionary to check the spelling of any words that they found challenging. This will also enable them to check that the meaning of the word is suitable for the sentence. 	 A mixture of Fiction and Non-Fiction writing Using the Henry Moore art as a starting point. (Image below). Think about how it would be to sleep in the London Underground tunnels. What can you see, smell, hear? How do you feel? What are you allowed to take with you? Create a piece of writing from a child's point of view. Why did people sleep in the Underground tunnels? Do you have family members who lived through these times, if so, collect their memories and write a biography. For quality work, some of this will take more than one session to complete.

Artist Henry Moore is best known for his sculptures, however during the war he worked as an artist. His most drawings are of people sleeping on the platforms on the London Underground. What do you notice about the colours he uses? Look how he shows the roundness of the tunnels. Can you create a similar piece of work?
