Weekly Maths Tasks (aim to do one per day)	Weekly Reading Tasks (aim to do one per day)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Do you know the rhyme for how many days in each month? Practise it- write it down if it helps!</li><li>Can you work out how many days it is until your next birthday? Use column addition to help you! It is only 7 until mine so I got the easy task!</li><li>Use your clock that you made last week. Ask a grown up to quick-fire some different times for you to find on it.</li><li>Can you create some times and convert them into digital times. E.g. quarter past 4 in the morning = 04:15am</li><li>Create a dominos set to match the analogue with the digital</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Daily reading to adult and adults reading to children</li><li>Pretend that you and the main character are having a conversation. Write down your questions and their answers.</li><li>Design a poster to advertise your favourite book. Why should I read it?</li><li>Choose 5 words from your story and change them using a thesaurus. If you haven't got one at home there is an online thesaurus too. Ask a grown up to help you find it.</li><li>Design a house for the main character to live in.</li></ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Look at the Year 3 / 4 common exception word list. Pick a different 5 words for this week and:</li></ul> <p>-Write the words out in alphabetical order</p> <p>-Put them into sentences</p> <p>-Write them in the air</p> <p>Practise them throughout the week.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Can you think of some words ending in the suffixes 'en' 'ed' 'er' or 'ing'? Write them down.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Write a persuasive letter to me or Mrs Moncrieff persuading us to visit your island.</li><li>Make a survival kit checklist for living on your island.</li><li>Make a poem about your Island.</li><li>This task might take up 2 days:</li></ul> <p>Choose an island near us. Create a fact file about it. Include pictures, labels and diagrams.</p>
