<p><b>This week's theme is Place Value.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Please work on <b>Summer Week 9 (Week beginning 15/6)</b> of <a href="https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year1/">https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year1/</a></li><li>There should be lessons on BBC Bitesize Year 1 from 15/6.</li><li>There are clips to help <a href="https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/z8sfr82">https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/z8sfr82</a></li><li><b>Play Purple Mash-Mathematics-Place Value-Ages 5 to 7</b> (in the darker brown) <b>-Reading Numbers to 20</b> and <b>Sequencing Numbers</b> and <b>Missing Numbers</b></li><li>Look at numbers around the house and ask the what the number is? How many tens and ones there are?</li><li>Use objects around the house and count to different numbers.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Read every day to another member of you house.</li><li>Where possible have a story read to you.</li><li>Watch and read Supertato <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=QlaMeNmTG6c">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=QlaMeNmTG6c</a></li><li>Now write the answers to these questions. <p><b>This week's words are:</b> <b>saw, draw, law, yawn, crawl, author, August, dinosaur, astronaut, sauce</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Play <b>Purple Mash-English-Spelling-Year 1-Summer 1 Week 1</b></li><li>Write sentences about yawn, crawl, August, astronaut and sauce.</li><li>Play <b>Purple Mash-English-Phonics3-igh 'ear' as in ear</b></li><li>Play <b>Purple Mash-English-Grammar-Hatching Out-Fruit tree words</b> (This about plurals adding s or es).</li><li>Make a list of nouns that add just s</li><li>Words that have es as plurals end in <b>ch, sh, ss, zz or x</b>. Make a list with pictures of words that follow this rule.</li></ul> <p><b>e.g. a church      churches</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Draw, label and write about your own superhero. Think about special powers and how he/she became a superhero. Do they have a special friend? There are various methods online some use baking powder or lemon juice and some need heat.</li></ul>
