







Morning communication

Whilst we do not feel the need to open the playground in the morning, as staff feel the routine of children going straight into class works best. We do however understand, you might need to speak to the class teacher, so we recommend that if this is the case, please go directly to the classroom and speak with a staff member. (If is not urgent, please tell a member of staff on the gate to pass on a message or even ask whether a member of staff can phone during the morning.)

After school Clubs

We do hope to continue to develop our offering with not just sports clubs, but possible art, crafts drama and cooking clubs. Watch this space!

Daily Mile Track

As a school we are provided by the government with a Sports fund, part of what we deliver and use the money on is for something sustainable to the school. Having been in many schools I have seen the difference a quick jog or walk can do to a child's well-being. This is also helps to increase physical activity across the day. The field unfortunately becomes so wet, a track would allow us to be with nature, as well as increase physical activity every day. This is something quite different to walking around Horsington – which we would not be able to do every day.

The track would not come from our school budget, it is an extra one for sport/PE.

Car Park

Unfortunately, the parish council owns the car park, so we are unable to do anything, though we appreciate the potholes and puddles are not great.

Governors

As you can appreciate our Governors are volunteers, who also have jobs. So unfortunately, they are not always available during school hours. However, they work tirelessly for the school. We are going to be adding a Governor update on our school newsletter, with photographs etc... to keep you informed.

Modern Foreign Language

We hope that ALL children from September will have the opportunity to learn French, starting with simple songs and greetings in EYFS to ordering at a shop in Year 6.

PTFA Communication

The PTFA work really hard to support the school with extra resources, trips etc... We appreciate that not everyone is on social media and so communication may not reach all. We are looking in ways to develop this and also enable more parents to become involved.
