Thank you to the children in Earth class for selling the poppy merchandise and raising a total of £78.10 for the RBL.












Aeronautics

This week as part of their English and Geography curriculum, Year 2 have written letters, addressed envelopes, and walked to the post box to send them home! We hope you enjoyed reading them!






The Newt
